

TIGG LLC AWARDED THE CHANGE ORDER ON TWO ADDITIONAL PFOA/PFOS TREATMENT SYSTEMS FOR THE CITY OF MARTINSBURG

OAKDALE, Pa. — (July 25, 2017) — The Martinsburg City Council voted to award Oakdale, Pennsylvania-based TIGG, LLC a change order for two additional GAC (Granular Activated Carbon) units for the Big Springs Water Filtration Plant. The revenue associated with the change order brings a grand total of \$1.4 million to the project.

PFCs, perfluorinated compounds, prompted the Martinsburg plant to be shut down in May 2015. These chemicals are believed to cause cancer, liver damage and birth defects, the EPA has established health advisories for these chemicals.

All four systems are tentatively scheduled to be delivered in early November to meet the treatment objectives. The system, when complete, will treat up to 5.8 million gallons of water per day.
